

# WABASH COUNTY COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS ELECTRONIC HOME DETENTION CRITERIA

To be eligible for the Electronic Home Detention Program, defendants must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Must not have pending charges or active warrants (IC 35-38-2.5-7).
- 2) Must not be charged or convicted of a violent offense based on IC 35-38-2.5-4.7

  - Escape IC 35-44.1-3-5
  - Criminal Stalking IC 35-45-10-5
  - Resisting Law Enforcement as a Felony IC 35-44-3-3
- 3) Must not have failed a previous placement in the EHD Program.
- 4) Must not be convicted of what would have been an "A" or "B" Felony (Advisory Board requirement).
- 5) May be rejected by Community Corrections staff based on prior criminal history.
- 6) May be rejected from EHD program based on other residents living in the home.
- 7) Must have the final approval of the Community Corrections Director.
